

HARTLEY'S LAGOON A 20 minute boat ride

Please make your way to the Departure Area five minutes before your allocated cruise time. Explore the natural habitat of the Estuarine Crocodile in safety on our specially constructed vessels. Learn about the importance of melaleuca wetlands and admire the crocodile's hunting skills during the pole feed. Crocodile sightings are guaranteed!

WILDLIFE DISCOVERY TRAIL 720m loop

Meet some large Estuarine Crocodiles including Gregory, a 750kg monster! Compare the physical differences between Estuarine (Saltwater) and Australia's Freshwater Crocodile. Marvel at the colourful birds in the aviary and study the prehistoric looking lizards and turtles. See colourful snakes and lizards at the reptile display - Gallery of Living Art.

GONDWANA GATEWAY 650m return

A walk-through sanctuary, home to kangaroos, wallabies and native bird life. Follow the path into the forest to discover some interesting native animals, including fruit bats and wombats. The interpretative signage explains how isolation and adaptation over millions of years shaped Australia's marsupials and reptiles.

CASSOWARY WALK 470m return

The pathway descends into a riparian rainforest growing along the banks of Tin Creek. Beyond the Cassowary enclosures, a pathway leads to the Predatory Bird Walk-Through Aviary and Rainforest Restoration Area.

CROCODILE FARM 280m return

Access by guided tour only. Tour departs Farm Information Display at 9.00am & 1.00 pm daily. Learn how a commercial crocodile farm works and why sustainable utilisation is important for the long term conservation of crocodiles. Eggs collected on site are artificially incubated. After hatching, the crocodiles grow to 1.8m within 3 years.

Enjoy hot and cold meals at Lilies Licenced Restaurant, overlooking Hartley's Lagoon (9.30am to 2.30pm). Coffee, cold drinks and snacks are available from 8.30am to 4.00pm.

Both attractions are in the Kuranda Heritage Markets, Rob Veivers Drive, Kuranda. Only 15 mins drive from Smithfield.

This boutique wildlife park features the best of Australian wildlife and you can pat or hold a friendly Koala for a large souvenir photo (extra cost). Besides many Koalas, the park is home to wombats, quokkas, gliders, and freshwater crocodiles. Hand-feed our tame kangaroos and wallabies, then discover the walk-thru nocturnal exhibit.

Surround yourself in a lush tropical rainforest meeting water birds, finches, pigeons, cockatoos, and the majestic cassowary.
